When the project began over 25 years ago the four alternatives currently under consideration was being studied. As a result of that study, alternate 3 was selected as the preferred alternative. When the study resumed, resource agencies such as (US Army Corps of Engineers, US Fish and Wildlife, Federal Highway Administration, Division of Water Quality, and others) recommended that we take a look at all of the alternatives studied in the original study.
